



# BOWL ALBERTA YBC COMBO TEAM PROVINCIALS

## **Format:**

- See Bowl Canada Program Manual for event format for a League Round.
- Make up of Three Player Teams of all Boys, all Girls, or Mixed consisting of a Bantam, a Junior, and a Senior.
- NOTE: To fill a vacant spot, ONE bowler in ONE age category (either Male or Female) may be moved up by ONE category only. That is, a Bantam Boy or Bantam Girl may be moved up to fill a Junior spot, or a Junior Boy or Junior Girl may be moved up to fill a vacant Senior spot, but Bantams SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO FILL A SENIOR VACANCY.

## **League Round:**

- Each Centre may advance to the Provincial Finals, based on the number of Franchises purchased (see **Bowl Alberta Program Registration**).
- See Bowl Alberta Calendar of Events to determine league round schedule ([www.bowlab.ca](http://www.bowlab.ca)).
- 4 Games, POA

## **Provincial Round:**

- North, Central and South divisions have been determined at the start of the season (See [www.bowlab.ca](http://www.bowlab.ca)).
- Averages as of (See **Bowl Alberta Calendar of Events**).
- Teams will bowl in the order of:
  1. Bantam
  2. Junior
  3. Senior
- 4 Games, POA
- Late Comers shall start to score when they arrive. Only legal bowled frames shall count, all frames not bowled shall be counted as zero.
- Ties: No tie breaker rule in effect. Should a tie(s) occur for medal positions following the compilation of the Provincial Results, extra medallions will be awarded and shipped to the affected centres competitors if necessary.
- One Coach allowed per Team.
- Medallions awarded to top three Teams (North & South).
- Linage paid by Bowl Alberta at Provincials.
