

BOWL ALBERTA BAKER'S CUP

FORMAT:

Tournament Format: Baker's Triple Format (3-person teams). Each bowler bowls one frame in rotation for all games. POA Team Event with No-Tap Format.

Eligibility: Open to all bowlers 18 years of age or older as of December 31 of the current bowling season who are registered in an Adult Member Centre League.

General Rules

- Teams consist of three (3) bowlers.
- Each game will be bowled using the Baker format, with bowlers rotating frames in the same order throughout the game.
- All rounds will be pins over average.
- Averages are based on previous season average.
- Lineups remain the same for tournament.
- Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers' Association rules apply.
- Late bowlers may join at the completion of the current game.
- Tie for prize positions will be split equally unless otherwise stated by tournament rules.
- All disputes shall be decided by the Bowl Alberta Official in charge.

Centre Round

- Centres determine their qualifying process and number of advancing teams based on their allocated entries.
- Teams bowl a minimum of nine (9) Baker Triple games (equals 3 games/person).
- Teams pay their own lineage.

Provincial Round

- Provincials will be divided into North and South, unless otherwise announced.
- Teams bowl twelve (12) Baker Triple games (equals 4 games/person).
- POA Team Event with No-Tap Format.
- Prize payouts will be determined annually by the Bowl Alberta Board.
